

# Giving at All Saints Kesgrave

There are many ways to give to the work of **All Saints Kesgrave (ASK)**, in time, talents, and in financial resources.

The following pages provide advice for donating funds, for both **Regular Giving** (known as Stewardship) and **Occasional Giving**. Advice slips are provided for you to tear off and use accordingly.

**If you do not attend church** but you have an affinity with All Saints as a special place and you'd like to ensure that our building is here for the future and for others, please register as a **Friend of ASK**. Your donations will go towards the upkeep of our historic church building.

An explanation of terms used in this leaflet:

- **Gift Aid** enables us to reclaim any tax that you have already paid on your donation. If you are a tax payer, simply complete the gift aid declaration on this form or on the giving envelope you use, to convert every £1 you give into £1.25 value to us, at no extra cost to yourself.


- **Give as You Earn (GAYE)** is the most effective way to give if you are on a payroll. Donations are taken from your gross salary, which means you can donate 25p more per £ (or 67p more per £ for a higher rate tax payer) without it costing you a penny more personally. In addition, your employer donates to us still more on top! If your employer supports GAYE, you can set this up with your payroll department using the account details in this leaflet.

- A **Standing Order** is a regular, automatic donation to us direct from your bank account, removing administration costs and time. You can set this up using the standing order mandate form attached.

- **Stewardship Envelopes** are for regular giving during the collection at church services and can be ordered using the advice slip attached. Use these where Standing Order or GAYE are not appropriate.

Remember to register with us using the advice slip attached. We'll provide you with a Stewardship number and/or a Friends number which will simplify administration for All Saints and for you. You'll also receive an annual Stewardship and/or Friends newsletter.

# Occasional Giving

For **occasional giving** which is ad-hoc, such as one off donations, the most popular method to use is the "Giving Envelopes" which can be found on the church pews.

If your donation is for a specific purpose (e.g. a fund raiser for a specific item), please indicate this purpose on the envelope, so we can be sure that we restrict the use of your donation accordingly.

If you pay tax then you can Gift Aid your donation, increasing it's value by 25%, by entering your details on the giving envelope, or by writing on the envelope your Stewardship Number or your Friends Number.

You can also make a one-off bank transfer to our account details below. In this case if you pay tax and you have not already registered for gift aid, please do so using the advice slip attached.
